RESIDENT SURVEY

Rosewood conducted a survey of residents in June and July 202l. The overall satisfaction with Rosewood was 89% (equivalent to the benchmark result across other equivalent organisations). CLINICAL CORNER

Restrictive Practice legislation: From I July 202I, amendments to the Aged Care Act and Quality of Care Principles have been implemented to minimise the use of restrictive practices (restraints) in Aged Care. Informed consents must be obtained for each/all restrictive practices.

As Rosewood is a secure facility, all residents are potentially subject to "Environmental Restraint". To maintain balance between ensuring the safety of all residents and maintaining freedom of movement, approved residents will be given swipe-card access, subject to clinical assessment. Some residents may not be assessed as suitable for use of a swipe card but, may ask staff to open doors for them.

If you have received a request to sign an Environmental Restraint Consent form for yourself or your loved one, please complete and return to Natalie Tan as soon as possible. Any questions, as always, please don't hesitate to ask.

ORAL CARE

For the month of September Rosewood is looking to improve oral care within the facility, we will be pushing toolboxes and education for the staff to highlight the importance and impact of maintaining good oral health.

Optimal dental health is important to maintain quality of life so that your loved ones can talk comfortably and confidently, enjoy eating comfortably, maintain confidence in their appearance, stay pain free, maintain habits/ standards of oral health they have had during their life. It is also important for medical reasons: to minimise sources of microorganisms from the mouth that may later involve other parts of the body, to manage medication side effects, to detect dental pain, to assist with nutritional intake and minimise the risk of unnecessary tooth extractions.

We are due to have the government dental screening completed on the I2th of October, please complete the consent forms for your loved one if you have not already done so.
