PODIATRY

AIR CONDITIONING

Air conditioning at West Perth - The base temperature at West Perth has been reset to 23 degrees. Each resident's room can be adjusted +/- 1.5 degrees around this base temperature. Conditions will be monitored to see if the temperature suits most.

When the window and/or outside door in a resident's room is opened, the air conditioning will turn off. So, if it is too cold in the room, opening the window/outside door will allow warm air from outside inside.

Leederville's base temperature is currently set at 22.5 degrees with possible adjustment +/- 1.5 degrees.

MAINTENANCE

If visitors notice maintenance or cleaning issues, please approach the nurse on duty or Samantha Hayward, Leederville Operations Manager or David Jennings, West Perth Operations Manager.

The Operations Managers are the first point of contact for any issues at the facilities.
